HAIR CUTTERYS' SHARE A HAIRCUT PROGRAM OFFERS FREE HAIRCUTS TO BROWARD COUNTY'S FOSTER YOUTH

PLANTATION, FL – ChildNet, the private, not for profit organization created to manage the child welfare system in Broward County, has partnered with Hair Cuttery to provide free haircuts to local foster care youth. Between August 1st and August 15th every time anyone 18 years or younger gets a haircut at a Hair Cuttery salon, a free haircut voucher will be given to a local foster care youth.

Suzanne Baker, ChildNet's In-Kind Coordinator, has worked with the Hair Cuttery for more than six years to bring the Share A Haircut program to Broward County's foster care children. "When a child starts his first day of the school year with a new haircut, there is a boost to their self-esteem and they feel better about themselves," says Suzanne Baker.

Emilio Benitez, ChildNet's Chief Executive Officer, urges the community to support the Share A Haircut program. "As you make back to school preparations for your children, include a haircut at the Hair Cuttery and you can give the same gift to foster children in need," says Emilio Benitez.
