FAQ'S

HOW OLD DO I HAVE TO BE TO VOLUNTEER?

KID volunteers need to be at least 16 to volunteer on campus. Can't wait until your 16th birthday? Check out how you can make a difference in the "Volunteers Under 16" section above.

DO I HAVE TO VOLUNTEER EVERY WEEK?

We ask that volunteers commit to spending at least 2 hours per week when volunteering with our Aftercare and Preschool programs.

DO I HAVE TO PASS A BACKGROUND CHECK?

Yes, passing a Level 2 background check is a requirement for all individual volunteers, even if you are not volunteering directly with the children. We are investing in our volunteers and cover the cost associated with the background check.

DO I HAVE TO DO AN ORIENTATION?

Yes, after your background check is completed a member of the Volunteer Team will contact you to set up your orientation. This is a quick tour around KID before your first volunteer shift.
