- Q. How is the required 25% matching implemented through the budget?
- A. Match requirement is not part of the budget submission. It is a contractual requirement of the funding source utilized to support the contract.
- Q. What is the number of kids that would be assigned for this contract for \$723,000?
- A. The Lead Agency metrics for finalized adoptions in Fiscal Year 2024-2025 is 110.
- Q. Is there co location opportunities or does rent need to be included in the budget?
- A. There is no option for co-location.
- O. What other office related costs should be considered?
- A. Respondent should consider costs that are allowable, reasonable, and necessary to operate the program.
