

PROCEDURES AND FORMS

Baker Act Florida statute 394.463 allows for involuntary examination of an individual (what some call emergency or involuntary commitment). It can be initiated by judges, law enforcement officials, physicians or mental health professionals. There must be evidence that the person 1). has a mental illness as defined in the Baker Act; 2). is a harm to self, harm to others, or is self-neglectful. A person may not be held in a receiving facility for longer than 72 hours.
