

## GOAL ONE

## ChildNet Child Advocates are able to deliver high quality services to ensure the safety, permanency and well-being of the children receiving services.

- ChildNet Child Advocates have manageable caseloads to provide the best service delivery to the children and families under their supervision.
- Client Services and related areas meet outcomes for children and families performing at or above all Department of Children and Families (DCF) contracted outcome measure targets.
- ChildNet maintains an up-to-date Quality Improvement process that assists case management to make improvements based on information gathered and reviewed for accountability and timely follow-up on recommendations.
- ChildNet understands and implements the need for excellent performance as shown through data.
- ChildNet implements related technology for excellent performance and accountability.

## **GOAL TWO**

ChildNet Child Advocates and their immediate supervisors are able to complete their duties in a confident and positive manner which includes access to improved resources.

- ChildNet Child Advocates are highly involved and motivated experts in child welfare and cutting edge business consultants are used as needed to ensure positive performance.
- Financial staff members manage the budget by using and explaining projections and trends for the Board to use to manage performance on meeting budgetary targets and future needs.

- ChildNet engages participants in the community to recruit family-like placements for children, including children with special needs and sibling groups, with a goal that the first placement should be the only placement until a permanent home is found.
